



Athletes with Disabilities Program

The Bank of America Chicago 13.1 strives to provide accessibility for all athletes with disabilities through the Athletes with Disabilities Program. This program is open to all athletes with a permanent physical, intellectual or vision impairment. When completing the registration process, participants are asked if they will be participating in the Athletes with Disabilities category. Anyone responding 'yes' to this question will be contacted by the Athletes with Disabilities Coordinator who will work directly with the participant to ensure that their specific needs are addressed.

Wheelchair Division

Wheelchair athletes may compete in the Bank of America Chicago 13.1 utilizing a push-rim racing or other manual wheelchair. The wheelchair field will begin 10 minutes ahead of the elite open wave.

Ambulatory Athletes with Disabilities

Athletes with Disabilities who are ambulatory, including those with a visual impairment, hearing impairment, physical impairment or intellectual impairment will be offered accommodations, including Guide Runners or Support Runners, as needed at packet pick up and for race day. Ambulatory athletes with disabilities may start in the Athletes with Disabilities start area as part of Corral D or in a regularly assigned start corral.
